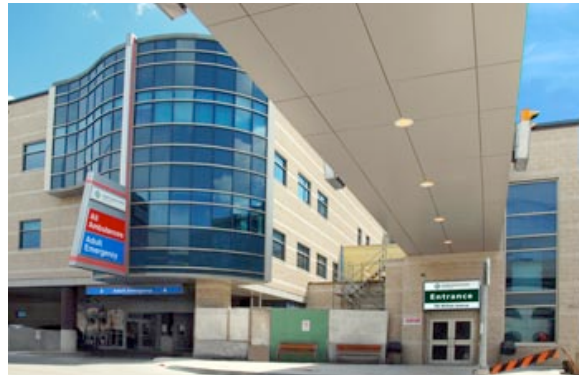


Women's Hospital Redevelopment Project Health Sciences Centre Winnipeg, Manitoba

PROJECT SUMMARY

The Health Sciences Centre (HSC) Winnipeg is one of the largest health care referral, teaching and research centres in Canada. It has the largest Women's Program in Manitoba with over 5,000 births, 7,000 gynecology surgeries and 29,000 ambulatory care visits annually. The outdated aging physical structure of its Women's Hospital and its geographical distance from other critical services and programs on the HSC campus had presented serious concerns. The new Women's Hospital will address modern operational and architectural requirements to manage the current and future needs of the facility.



The scheduled completion of this \$275,000,000 project is 2014.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Integrated Designs is the LEED/Sustainable Design Consultant representing the Owner for this 247,000 sq.ft redevelopment project, and will ensure that the project meets the requirements for the targeted LEED Silver certification level and the provincial government's Green Building Policy, within the framework of an integrated design process.
