Budget: \$12,500,000

- IDI was responsible for external project management (outside of the University) and advising the commissioning team.
- Green roof and displacement ventilation
- 100% outdoor air with heat recovery provides good indoor air quality
- Radiant heating and cooling panels provide excellent thermal comfort
- Innovation points for education, water use, green housekeeping, LEED-CI furniture
- Other projects at U of S include design facilitation for the LEED Gold Aboriginal Student Centre, LEED facilitation for the Student Union redevelopment and LEED CI commissioning for the Murray Library.
